How to Prepare and File a Form I-765, Employment Authorization Document (EAD)

What is an EAD?

This form is filed when you are requesting a work authorization document (work permit) that allows you to legally work in the United States. You may also use to request a Social Security Number, another form of identification.

USCIS issues the following types of EADs:

Initial EAD: This document allows you to work in the United States

Replacement EAD: Replaces lost, stolen, or mutilated EAD. Can also replace an EAD with incorrect information, such as misspelled name

Renewal EAD: Renews your EAD. Do not file more than 180 days after expiration.

NOT ALL NONCITIZENS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR EADS!

Who qualifies for an EAD?

EADs require an eligibility category. The most common are:

- C (8): Asylum applications that have been pending for 150 days
- > C (9): Pending Adjustment of Status, (Green Card)
- C (11): Parolee by receiving CBP and presenting at Port of Entry

<u>1A-1C. Full Legal Name</u>: Provide full name in the following order: Last name(s), First name, Middle name

5A-5F. Your U.S. Mailing Address: Confirm this is a safe address to receive mail from. USCIS will mail your receipt and EAD to the address you provided.

8. Alien Registration Number (A-number):

What is an A-number?

A nine-digit number that can be found on most immigration documents, forms, and petitions.

- ▶ Form I-94, Arrival/Departure Record
- EAD or LPR card, if renewing

<u>13-17B. Social Security Number:</u> Write in your social security number, if you have one. If you would like to receive one, mark **'YES'** on **14-15** and provide full name of father and mother on **16.A.-17.B.**



What to Include with your EAD Application:

- **1.** Form I-765, Application for Employment Authorization
- 2. Form I-912, Fee Waiver, if you qualify
- 3. Form I-94 (Arrival/Departure record) if you received one

- **4.** Proof asylum application has been pending more than 150 days, such as stamp on application or receipt notice
- **5. Proof of Identification:** copy of passport, consular ID, Matricula, or birth certificate (with English translations)
- 6. Two (2) Passport Style Photos

Part 3: Information about your Last Arrival

21A. Form I-94 Arrival-Departure record: If applicable, you would provide the Admission (I-94) Number found on your Form I-94. You may also use to find the following:

- Admit until date
- Date of your last arrival into U.S.
- Immigration Status of Last Arrival

24. Immigration Status at Your Last

<u>Arrival:</u> Provide the letter/number that matches your status when you entered. Can be found on visa or Form I-94

25.Your Current Immigration Status

<u>27. Eligibility Category:</u> enter (letter) (number) under space provided.
