

When and How to File form I-589, Application for Asylum and for Withholding of Removal

What is Asylum?

You may be eligible for Asylum if you have suffered past persecution or fear of future persecution based on your

- A) Race
- B) Religion
- C) Nationality
- D) Political Opinion
- E) Political Social Group

**You Must apply for Asylum
within ONE YEAR of your entry
to the United States**

AND

The government in your country is unwilling or unable to protect you or the government is persecuting you.

When to file for Asylum Affirmatively or Defensively

Are you in Removal Proceedings with Immigration Court? Do you have a scheduled court hearing? Have you received a Notice to Appear or Notice of Hearing?

If you are under 18 and not living with either of your parents and/or have ever been in an ORR shelter – please consult with an attorney to determine if you would need to file defensively or affirmatively
