
WHAT TO DO IF ICE ENTERS YOUR HOSPITAL?

Remind yourself and others of their constitutional rights:

- The right to remain silent
- The right to speak to an attorney
- The right to not sign anything without an attorney present

Ask ICE agents if they have a warrant

- ICE can enter public areas inside the hospital
- ICE <u>CANNOT</u> enter private areas of the hospital <u>without a warrant</u>
 Warrant must be issued by U.S. Court and signed by U.S. Judge





Document ICE activity:

- Write or record the search and note the following:
 - Date, time, and location of the event
 - Badge numbers or names of the ICE agents
 - What they say and how they interact with you and others
