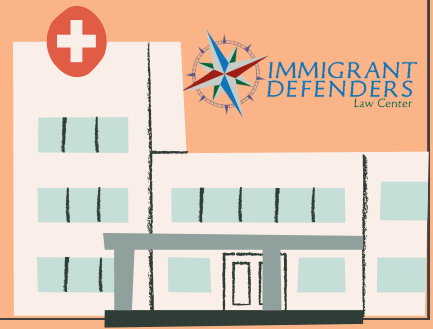


KNOW YOUR RIGHTS: HOSPITALS



WHAT TO DO IF ICE ENTERS YOUR HOSPITAL?



Remind yourself and others of their constitutional rights:

- The right to remain silent
- The right to speak to an attorney
- The right to not sign anything without an attorney present



Ask ICE agents if they have a warrant

- ICE can enter public areas inside the hospital
- ICE **CANNOT** enter private areas of the hospital **without a warrant**
 - Warrant must be issued by U.S. Court and signed by U.S. Judge

I have determined that there is probable cause to believe that _____ is removable from the United States. This determination is based upon:

- ☐ the execution of a charging document to initiate removal proceedings against the subject;
- ☐ the pendency of ongoing removal proceedings against the subject;
- ☐ the failure to establish admissibility subsequent to deferred inspection;
- ☐ biometric confirmation of the subject's identity and a review of federal databases that affirmatively indicate, by themselves or in addition to other reliable information, that the subject either lacks immigration status or notwithstanding such status is removable under U.S. immigration law; and/or
- ☐ statements made voluntarily by the subject to an immigration officer and/or other reliable evidence that affirmatively indicate the subject either lacks immigration status or notwithstanding such status is removable under U.S. immigration law.

YOU ARE COMMANDED to arrest and take into custody for removal proceedings under the Immigration and Nationality Act, the above-named alien.

Unless delayed notice is authorized below, you must give a copy of the warrant and a receipt for the property taken to the person from whom, or from whose premises, the property was taken, or leave the copy and receipt at the place where the property was taken.

The officer executing this warrant, or an officer present during the execution of the warrant, must prepare an inventory as required by law and promptly return this warrant and inventory to United States Magistrate Judge Hon. David H. Barick.



Document ICE activity:

- Write or record the search and note the following:
 - Date, time, and location of the event
 - Badge numbers or names of the ICE agents
 - What they say and how they interact with you and others
